


- Survey focus:

Daily share of viewing time (%), ETV+ and PBK



Importance of different media channels as sources of information



Importance of different media channels as sources of information 2014 and 2017








Importance of different media channels as sources of information




Responses: very important+quite important, other nationalities by age group



Importance of different types of media channels, other nationalities




Typology of

Conclusions

- Persisting differences between ethnic Estonians and other nationalities in media orientation
- Increase of importance of web-based media, growing heterogeneity
- Media orientation of other nationalities related to knowledge of Estonian language and state identity, at the same time, knowledge of Estonian does not reduce the importance of Russian(-language) media
- Widenging gap between media use of young and older people
