ATTENDING ESTONIAN LANGUAGE COURSES

- Adults **from the age of 18** are welcome to attend our courses.
- We learn Estonian in Estonian.
- Each language course can be taken **only once**.
- Attending the course requires regular participation in learning activities and independent work.
- Our students have different cultural backgrounds and mother tongues. Together we create a friendly
 and respectful learning environment.

SUCCESSFUL LANGUAGE LEARNING

- Language skills develop best when you set yourself a specific **goal** to achieve the desired level, invest **time in** learning, study **independently** in addition to the language course and practise communicating in Estonian **every day**.
- We communicate with the teacher and fellow students in **Estonian** as much as possible in class, during



breaks and in writing.

• You can use **free digital solutions** (apps, websites, etc.) to support your language learning. You will find an overview of them on our website.

LEARNING ACTIVITIES

- Each course lasts for at least 120 academic hours.
- Classes are held 2-3 times a week for 2-4 academic hours at a time.
- The schedule of classes remains the same throughout the course.
- The course consists of **lessons**, **independent work**, **study visits** and other activities supporting language learning.
- The teacher chooses suitable teaching materials taking into account the needs of the group.

PARTICIPATION IN CLASSES

- Attendance of a class is confirmed with the student's signature.
- If you know you will be absent from or late for a class, please notify the teacher in writing at least 24 hours in advance, explaining why.
- Following a fourth consecutive unjustified absence, the teacher considers the student to have quit the course.
- Please arrive 10 minutes before the start of the lesson so that the teacher can start it on time.
- If you are sick, please do not attend the lesson.

COMPLETING THE COURSE

- At the end of the course you can take an Estonian language level exam at the Innove Foundation (innove.ee).
- Certification of course completion is awarded to language learners who complete 75-100% of the course.
- A certificate of partial completion is provided to students who complete 50-74% of the course.
- Students who participate in 75-100% of the course can continue language learning at the next level by informing their teacher in writing of their wish to do so.



- For participants who take part in less than 50% of lessons, we recommend contacting an advisor at the Estonian Language House, who will help determine further learning opportunities.
